KIND OF MEETING: EXCEL Capital Improvement Building Project Vote

POLLING PLACES: The Altona Town Hall, the Lyon Mountain Fire Station, the Churubusco Town Hall, and the MS/HS at Ellenburg

The Inspector at each of the four polling places opened the polls precisely at 12:00 noon. Citizens proceeded to vote until 8:00 PM, at which time the Inspectors declared the polls closed.

The results of the voting are as follows:

PROPOSITION:

Shall the Board of Education of the Northern Adirondack Central School District be authorized to undertake a project consisting of additions, renovations and site work at the District's Middle/High School and Elementary School (the "Project"), including construction of an approximately 26,000 gross square feet of new classrooms, a gymnasium including exterior accessed toilet/concession facilities, a new main entry and renovations and improvement to interior spaces at the Middle/High School, interior renovations and improvements, construction of a student drop-off loop, upgrades to the building's rear entrance and parking areas, upgrades to the existing athletic fields, construction of an additional basketball court and a new broken-back track and field facility including a competition soccer field at the Elementary School and engineering building system upgrades, building exterior improvements and code compliance improvements at the Middle/High School and Elementary School; and if necessary, the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the School District to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board of Education shall determine and in anticipation of such tax shall the School District be authorized to issue up to \$35,900,000 of obligations of the School District and, if necessary, levy a tax to pay the interest thereon when due.
