NOTES FROM THE NURSE

Summer weather dress code: According to the student handbook, there are dress code requirements. Students should not wear footwear that is a safety hazard such as flip-flops, plastic tong sandals and clogs. These are not appropriate in the school environment. Clothing such as tube tops, net tops, halter-tops, spaghetti straps and plunging necklines or see through garments are also not appropriate.

10-11 Kindergarten: Please remember to complete immunizations over the summer and have the documentation mailed or faxed to the school @ 594-7255. If you know of anyone who may have preschoolers eligible for 09-10 Kindergarten, please have them contact the elementary office.

Immunization requirements for 6th grade: Students who are entering 6th grade or are turning 11 must receive a Tdap shot (Tetanus, reduced diphtheria and acellular pertussis). Also, all students entering 6th grade must have documented proof of varicella (chicken pox) immunization or the disease.

These requirements are NYS Department of Health Mandates. These documents may be mailed or faxed to the attention of the nurse @ 594-7255.
